The learning outcomes for the three day course include:

Day 1: At the end of day one, participants should be able to:

- Understand the difference between monitoring, evaluation and research.
- Understand the elements of monitoring.
- Apply programme goals and objectives in developing a monitoring framework.
- Identify key stakeholders in programme monitoring and evaluation.
- Start developing their own monitoring and evaluation frameworks.

Day 2: At the end of day two, participants should be able to:

- Develop and select appropriate indicators for measuring programme outputs and outcomes.
- Understand methods and tools for data collection.
- Understand the rationale, key elements and steps required to develop a monitoring framework.

Day 3: At the end of day three, participants should be able to:

- Understand the use of monitoring data
- Understand the basic components of an evaluation.
- Identify evaluation questions for process and outcome evaluations

During the training, attendees have the opportunity to gain practical experience in developing their own monitoring systems. The goal of the workshop is to make monitoring and evaluation practical and thus useful.
